

COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS)

In consultation with the Chief Medical Officer of Health, the Ontario government has announced safety measures in an effort to reopen the province. As of June 12, 2020 the limit on social gatherings was increased with a 30% of the building capacity for places of worship in order to ensure the safety of worshipers. In addition, on July 7, 2020 a new bylaw was passed by the City of Toronto to legislate mandatory face covering in all enclosed public spaces. This legislation comes as an added measure for the protection of the health, safety, and well-being of all persons in Toronto.

We will continue to monitor the situation and take our lead from all levels of Governments, the Toronto Public Health (TPH) and Church of God in Ontario Regional Office. We cannot stress enough to be careful, take the necessary precautions and use the information given to protect yourself and your family. Please continue to exercise caution and follow public health advice in order to avoid a second wave of this deadly disease.
